# SOCCERWORLD ADULT PLAYER ROSTER ELIGIBILITY

(UPDATED REGULATION EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2009)

1. Players are permitted to play on more than one team at Soccerworld, but **NOT** on multiple teams in the same division.
2. All Soccerworld teams must have same colour jerseys and individual player numbers. NO SAME NUMBERS> All player names & matching numbers must be submitted to Soccerworld management.
3. **ABSOLUTELY NO swapping** of jerseys permitted to non-registered players.
4. Any teams using players not found on their roster are subject to forfeit. The opposing team is responsible for bringing illegal players to the attention of the official or league administrators. As employees of Soccerworld officials/referees have been instructed to be proactive to report any player roster infractions to management. Teams that commit an infraction to this rule will be reviewed by Soccerworld management and maybe expelled from Soccerworld with **NO REFUND**.
5. If a team is short of a player and would like to add a non-roster player in order to avoid forfeit, they must request permission from the opposing team captain, **AND** the new player(s) **MUST** fill out required insurance waiver forms with payment of \$15.75 (includes GST) membership fee. Allow a minimum 15 minutes prior to scheduled game for this process. If the opposing team is accepting, then the game result will stand.
6. Stand-in or extra players that have followed the process as outline in #5 (above) will be permanently added to your roster. ALL NEW PLAYERS ADDED TO TEAM ROSTER MUST have their own jersey and their number must be submitted to Soccerworld management for any future games.
7. If playing on multiple teams, players must fill out a registration form for each team and add the required forms to their respective team booklets. **Individual player membership fee now included with team fees and is valid for 365 days or 2009-2010 seasons.**
8. Players must check in with the scorekeeper prior to each game.
9. ALL Players must play a **MINIMUM OF 3 GAMES** to be eligible for playoffs.
10. It is the responsibility of the team captain to inform us if eligible players are missing from the roster. They will not be credited for the game if they are not on the roster.

# SOCCKER PAYMENT SCHEDULE

(UPDATED AUGUST 1, 2009)

1. Teams must pay a \$787.50 (includes 5% GST) deposit upon registration.
2. Teams must pay the remaining balance at least **48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE SECOND GAME** or not be allowed to play the game. (You may call and make arrangements to pay on the day of the game, but note that if you do then there will be no excuses accepted for non payment)
3. By 12 o'clock noon, on the day before the second game, if your balance is still not paid in full (or if you have not arranged to pay), then both captains will be contacted and the game will not be played. This game will be rescheduled **IF** your balance is paid in full at least 48 hours before the third game. **However, you will be fined a \$100.00 rescheduling fee, which will be added to your balance.**
4. **If your balance is still not paid by 12 o'clock noon on the day before the third game, then both captains will be contacted. The game will not be played and will not be rescheduled. You will be removed from the league and replaced by another team. You will also be banned from playing on any teams at Soccerworld Hamilton for the entire 2007-2008 season.**

# FINES AND SUSPENSIONS

(UPDATED FINES AUGUST 1, 2009)

Soccerworld Hamilton will be imposing a series of fines and punishments for violent conduct and disruptive behaviour. In light of past events at Soccerworld we have been forced to implement the following disciplinary sanctions:

<b><u>RED CARD</u></b>	<b>\$50.00 FINE (PER PLAYER) MINIMUM 1 GAME SUSPENSION</b>
<b><u>3 YELLOW CARDS</u></b>	<b>\$50.00 FINE (PER PLAYER)</b>

**FIGHTS on Field or within SoccerWorld Property (includes parking lot) \$300.00 TEAM FINE and potential expulsion of whole team without refund. Soccerworld is sanctioned by Hamilton District and the OSA, individual or team un-sportsmanlike conduct will be reported to these governing bodies which can result banning players/teams from playing soccer in other leagues including outdoor clubs.**

FAILURE TO DO THIS WILL INCUR A <b>\$50.00 FINE</b>. NO MAKE-UP GAMES, NO REFEREE REFUND.</b>

Our leagues are meant to be recreational in nature **violence will not be tolerated**. All fine monies will be donated to a charitable organization.

## INDOOR SOCCER RULES

## NUMER OF PLAYERS

1. Teams can dress a maximum of 18 players.
2. The games will be played with 5 players and 1 Goalkeeper.
3. A team must have a minimum of 4 players to begin a game.

## SUBSTITUTIONS

1. Substitutions can be made at any time during the game.
2. Players must enter and exit the field on their side of half, and only on the south side of the field. Failure to make changes within a reasonable distance from the bench may result in a penalty.
3. The referee must be notified, and must give permission before there is a goalkeeper change.

## DURATION OF THE GAME

1. All regular season games will consist of two 21 minute halves, with a 30 second break at half.
2. The clock will start promptly at the scheduled game time.
3. Teams will be given a 5 minute grace period (after the clock has started) to have a minimum of 4 players on the field or they will forfeit the game.

## EQUIPMENT

1. Players on the same team must all wear numbered shirts of the same colour. The goalkeeper must wear a shirt that is different from both teams.
2. All types of indoor soccer shoes are allowed, outdoor cleats are preferred.
3. Shin pads must be worn.
4. All wrist watches, head gear, and jewellery must be removed before playing.
5. Bibs will be supplied for the home team to wear if opposing jerseys are too similar.
6. Players under age 12 will use a size 4 ball. All other games will use a size 5 ball.
7. **TEAMS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING THEIR OWN FIRST AID, ICE PACKETS ARE AVAILABLE IN ON FIELD VENDING MACHINE AT \$2.00**

## TIE BREAKERS

1. No tie breaks during regular season play
2. Playoff ties will go straight to penalty kicks (5 shots each). No extra time.
3. Any 5 players from the game in question may shoot.
4. Ties in the league standings will be decided by the two teams' head to head result from the regular season.  
(Total wins, then goal differential, if needed)

## VIOLATIONS AND DISCIPLINE

1. All free kicks are indirect. Defenders must be 3 yards back from the ball.
2. All free kicks for the ball going out of bounds will be taken from where the ball went out, except for corner and goal kicks.
3. All netting is considered out of bounds.
4. Slide **TACKLES** are **NOT** permitted. Sliding for an open ball (away from all opponents) is not a tackle, and is permitted. Referees decisions are final.
5. There are no offsides in indoor soccer.
6. 2 minute penalties are issued at referee's discretion and are served in full, regardless of goals scored.
7. Penalty kicks must be taken by a player on the field at the time of the infraction.
8. Excessive foul language and ALL SPITTING are grounds for a 2 minute penalty.
9. **All red cards carry a minimum 1 game suspension and a \$50.00 fine.**
10. **All violent conduct, intent to injure and referee assaults will be reported to the Hamilton & District Soccer Association, and to the proper authorities, depending on the severity of the incident.**
